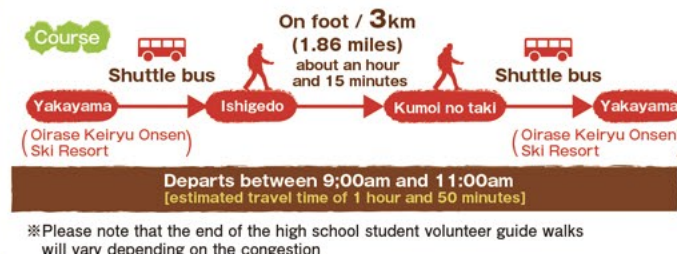

## To preserve the natural environment and eliminate traffic congestion.

The National Route 102 Oirase (Aobunazan) Bypass project was completed.

The Oirase Stream is the property of all of us and everyone has the right to enjoy it. However, there are various problems during tourist season, such as an influx of cars, traffic jams and environmental impact. The National Road 102 along the mountain Stream originally functioned as a local life road, and industrial road but it is difficult to pass large vehicles on the road that bypasses the mountain stream.

In order to solve these problems, from 2013, the "Aobunazan Bypass", which can safely bypass the Oirase stream was commercialized and maintained. At the Oirase Steamlined Utilization Council, we have been experim enting with Vehicle traffic restrictions for the purpose of "preserving the natural environment and eliminating traffic jams." Looking ahead, we will continually make strides in order to increase the number of vehicles and th e time limit, therefore we ask for your understanding and cooperation.
